Our repertoire includes:

- Soft tissue tumors, panniculitis, conjunctival, oral, vulvar, penile, vaginal, anal and perianal disorders
- Expert diagnosis of blisters and rashes
- Polarized light analysis of specimens
- Tissues submitted in alcohol can be analyzed for uric acid crystals (gout)

DIRECT IMMUNOFLUORESCENCE "DIF" Analysis (not indirect)
*Michel's fixative upon request: when considering DIF for bullous dermatoses, autoimmune diseases and other appropriate differential diagnoses

NAILS (finger and toe)
Fungal stains
Routine histology: melanoma, tumors, inflammatory dermatoses

Transmission ELECTRON MICROSCOPY "TEM" Analysis (when appropriate)
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PCR analysis (send out)
HPV infection and typing
